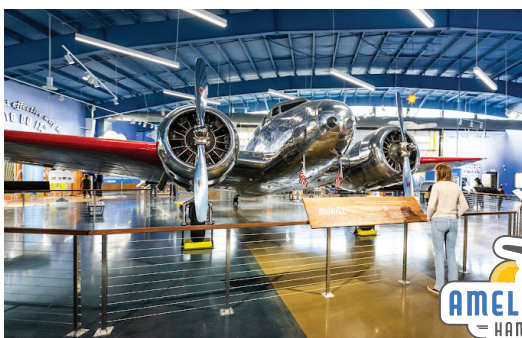
Evening Cocktail welcome and registration at Atchison Event Center.
